EXPRESS Pool Registration Do You Qualify?

In an effort to make registration for the pool a little easier for residents, we will be conducting **EXPRESS** pool registration again this spring. If you qualify for this **EXPRESS** method you may be able to avoid having to stand in line at the Community Center in May.

In order to qualify for **EXPRESS** registration you must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- you must have pool passes from a previous year;
- pool passes must have a bar code and be imprinted on the front with the year 2010;
- no one in the family needs a new pass (children turning 1, 5, 13 & 16 by 8/1/10 will need a new pass);
- renter's must provide, along with the pool registration form, a letter from the property owner turning over their pool privileges;
- the property assessment account must be up to date; and
- there can be no outstanding covenants violations for your property.

If you meet **all** of these criteria you can register for the pool using the **EXPRESS** process by filling out the form found here. You can mail your form, no passes, to the Association Office at 8201 Southrun Rd., Springfield, VA. 22153, or drop your form off at the Association Office, or e-mail your form to aanfca@verizon.net. If you wish to use the **EXPRESS** pool registration, all forms must be received **by no later than April 30, 2010**.

Please be sure to provide an e-mail address in the space indicated on the form to receive acknowledgment of your registration.

Children ages 8-12 must be able to swim one and a half laps of the pool, tread water for one minute, and be able to float to qualify as a swimmer. Parents who wish their children to enter the pool unaccompanied must arrange with the lifeguards for their children to take the swim test **each year**. Children 8-12 years old who have not passed the swim test given by the lifeguards must be in the company of an adult, or sibling age 13 or older, who will be responsible for the child at all times.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT: Pool passes are available to Newington Forest Community residents only and are non-transferable. Use of the Newington Forest Community Association pool is restricted to residents of the community and their paying guests. **Providing false information on this form regarding the resident status of any person will result in the loss of pool privileges for the entire family for the summer.**
